

SYNOPSIS

THE ELEPHANT 6 RECORDING CO. shares the unique inside story of the collective creative evolution behind the sounds of 1990s psychedelic rock bands the Olivia Tremor Control, Neutral Milk Hotel, and the Apples in Stereo – the founding groups behind the Elephant 6 collective, as well as a host of other artists -- with inspirational resonance for today's music makers, and music lovers everywhere.

Around 1985, a group of Ruston, Louisiana area high schoolers began experimenting with whatever random instruments and gear they could lay their hands on. Moving to other small college towns including Denver, Colorado and Athens, Georgia, their musical coming of age coincided with the new consumer availability of old-school 4 and 8 track recording technology and cassette tapes. Sharing like-minded sensibilities, influenced by past sounds and psychedelia, and with little to distract them, their efforts to create whole new musical worlds became the bands the Olivia Tremor Control, Neutral Milk Hotel, the Apples In Stereo and many more. While the collective grew to a natural breaking point, its founding members overcame obstacles and remained closely bonded, reuniting for tours and still collaborating today.

THE ELEPHANT 6 RECORDING CO. provides insight into this revolutionary era of popular independent music in America, the defiant DIY spirit in music making, and champions the integrity of an authentic quest for artistic expressiveness over the more mainstream image of being a "successful" musician in our fame-obsessed times.





DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

My connection to Elephant 6 began when I was 18 and I moved from a small central Kentucky town to Lexington, home of the University of Kentucky.

Much like the primary figures of Elephant 6, who spent their childhoods in Ruston, LA, I had grown up in a small rather isolated Southern town. As a teen, finding like-minded friends was difficult. Most kids there were farmers. I loved basketball, music and skateboarding. But much like Ruston, there was a small college in our town. The children of the local college professors became a lifeline of friendships lasting to this day. We formed bands, we recorded on 4-tracks, we read books, we turned each other onto weirder and smarter music. The lonely island got a little larger.

Around the same time I was leaving my small town and starting at the University of Kentucky, Robert Schneider of the Apples In Stereo was arriving from Denver to study mathematics there. One fateful night in downtown Lexington, Robert saw my friends John Ferguson and Ben Phelan playing a show with their band Big Fresh. John and Ben would eventually go on to join Robert as members of a new lineup of the Apples In Stereo.

I had already been making music videos and concert films for our friends' bands, so I decided to make a big six-camera shoot for an Apples concert in 2007. After seeing how that video turned out, Robert approached me and asked what I thought about making a documentary about the members of the Elephant 6 collective. At the time I knew nothing about them. But Robert seemed to think that my small-town background, along with his blessing, would allow me entrance to their somewhat secretive and protective world. And that's how it began.

Robert introduced me to Bill Doss of the Olivia Tremor Control, who in turn introduced me to his bandmate Will Cullen Hart. And on and on it went, each person connecting me with another member of this vast web of bands-- Julian Koster and Scott Spillane of Neutral Milk Hotel, Andrew Rieger and Laura Carter of Elf Power, Martyn Leaper and Rebecca Cole of the Minders, Hilarie Sidney and John Hill of the Apples In Stereo, Heather McIntosh of Circulatory System and the Instruments, and so many more members of the collective agreed to share their memories and their music for a film about Elephant 6.




DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT - CONTINUED

Greg King, a fellow Southerner who had performed in the band rachel's and edited the critically-acclaimed documentary City Of Gold, was the first collaborator to join as a member of the filmmaking team and help shape its creative vision. Greg brought on our Executive Producer and Music Supervisor Rob Hatch-Miller, Director of the record store documentary Other Music which Greg also edited. Lance Bangs -- a director and documentarian who had lived in Athens during the heyday of the collective -- also joined as a Producer, co-Cinematographer and interview subject, and shared his wealth of archival film and video of the bands in Athens which forms the bedrock of the film.

As the team for this project came together, what started out small and DIY grew into something much bigger and more ambitious. The film is designed to capture an era and a movement, and to honor the spirit of this circle of small-town artist friends. Their art was made better because they did things collectively, and gave each and every member a chance to share the spotlight.

BIOGRAPHIES



C.B. Stockfleth - DIRECTOR/PRODUCER

C.B. Stockfleth is a filmmaker currently based in New Orleans, LA. He grew up in Central Kentucky and dropped out of high school. He eventually went to film school at Full Sail University in Orlando. For the last 20 years, he's worked as a commercial director and photographer mostly in Louisville, KY. He's made music videos and live concert videos for bands including the Apples In Stereo and the Olivia Tremor Control, and has directed countless regional commercials and corporate videos. He's won awards for some of them.



Lance Bangs - PRODUCER

Lance Bangs is an artist, filmmaker and showrunner. He has created videos for Sonic Youth, Nirvana, Neutral Milk Hotel, Green Day, The Shins, Belle & Sebastian, Yeah Yeah Yeahs, R.E.M., Death Cab For Cutie, The Black Keys, Odd Future, Joe Strummer and George Harrison. Lance has also been heavily involved in the filming and production of the Jackass television series and its subsequent movies, and has directed documentaries about the bands Pavement and Slint. His work is in the permanent collection of the Museum of Modern Art in NY, The Georgia Museum, and Kunst-Werke in Berlin. As a resident of Athens, GA in the 1990s, he made films and videos documenting the Elephant 6 scene.



Greg King - EDITOR/PRODUCER

Greg King is a filmmaker, artist and musician based out of Los Angeles, CA. He was the editor of City Of Gold (Sundance Film Festival 2015), about Pulitzer Prize-winning writer Jonathan Gold, Other Music (about an influential New York City indie record store) and Louder Than You Think (about founding Pavement drummer Gary Young). Greg was a member of the indie-classical ensemble rachel's, and toured with the band across the US, Canada and Europe.



Rob Hatch-Miller - EXECUTIVE PRODUCER

Rob is a filmmaker and Producers Guild of America member based in Los Angeles, CA. He was one of Variety's 10 Documentary Filmmakers To Watch In 2019, and one of DOC NYC's 40 Under 40 documentary talents for 2019. He studied Film & TV at NYU's Tisch School Of The Arts. Rob directed and produced the music documentary features Other Music (Tribeca Film Festival 2019, currently streaming on Kanopy) and Syl Johnson: Any Way The Wind Blows (Best Documentary Feature, Sidewalk Film Festival 2016, currently streaming on Tubi).

FEATURED BANDS



THE APPLES IN STEREO

The Apples In Stereo were formed in Denver, CO in the early 1990s by Ruston, LA native Robert Schneider, along with Jim McIntyre (bass), Hilarie Sidney (drums) and Chris Parfitt (guitar). Around the same time that the band came together, Schneider and 3 childhood friends from Ruston — Jeff Mangum, Will Cullen Hart and Bill Doss — decided to form their own record label, the Elephant 6 Recording Co. The Apples released 9 albums between 1995 and 2010. Bandleader Robert Schneider received a PhD in Mathematics from Emory University in 2018, and is currently a professor at Michigan Technological University.



NEUTRAL MILK HOTEL

Neutral Milk Hotel began as a home recording project of Jeff Mangum in Athens, GA. In 1996, he traveled to Denver, CO to record the album On Avery Island with his childhood friend from Ruston, LA, Robert Schneider (the Apples In Stereo). Mangum recruited musicians Julian Koster, Jeremy Barnes, and Scott Spillane to join the band for a second album In The Aeroplane Over The Sea (Merge Records, 1998), which was also produced by Robert Schneider in Denver. While a third Neutral Milk Hotel album has never materialized, the band reunited for an extensive worldwide reunion tour starting in 2013.



THE OLIVIA TREMOR CONTROL

The Olivia Tremor Control was founded in Athens, GA in the summer of 1993 by Ruston, LA natives Bill Doss, Will Cullen Hart, and Jeff Mangum. An earlier incarnation of the band was called Synthetic Flying Machine. Jeff left soon after to form Neutral Milk Hotel. The Olivias released two albums — Music From The Unrealized Film Script: Dusk At Cubist Castle (1996) and Black Foliage: Animation Music Volume One (1999), recorded at their home studios and mixed and mastered by Robert Schneider at his Denver studio Pet Sounds. The band went on hiatus in 2000, and in the interim Hart released music with his project Circulatory System and Doss with his own, the Sunshine Fix. The Olivia Tremor Control reunited and toured again starting in 2005. While recording a third Olivias album in the summer of 2012, Bill Doss unexpectedly passed away at his home in Athens. He was 43 years old. The band's third album has never been completed.
